As we prepare to hear the blasts of the *שופר*, let us remind our children—and ourselves—that Hashem gives us fresh strength and potential every single year.

Wishing all of our pupils, parents, staff, and families a *כתיבה וחתימה טובה*—may we all be inscribed and sealed for a healthy, successful, and sweet new year.
